WHAT IS THE "CHANCE 2 GROW" FUND?

"Chance 2 Grow" is a fund within the Child and Family Services of Central Manitoba Foundation that pays registration fees and helps with equipment and supplies for a myriad of educational and recreational opportunities for children in need of financial support, up to a maximum of \$400 per year per child.



WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

All children and youth between the ages of 5 and 17 who reside in the Central Region of Manitoba and who meet the qualification of financial need. The program is run by the Child and Family Services of Central Manitoba Foundation, but the child's family does not need to be involved with the Agency in any way to qualify. The Central Region of Manitoba includes:



HOW DOES "CHANCE 2 GROW" WORK?

Application is made to the Child and Family Services of Central Manitoba Foundation for funding. Registration fees are paid directly to the organization where the child is enrolled. Funding for equipment, instruments, or supplies will be payable to the parent upon the Foundation receiving verification of the purchase. Receipts are required.

Eligibility is determined by family income. Verification of income is required as well as a parental contribution that is outlined on the application form.



WHAT DETERMINES FINANCIAL NEED?

Eligibility for the program is based on your household size and total family income. The following information will help you determine if your child is eligible:
